Re: NGB Recognition and USOC Membership

Dear Mr. Blackwood:

I am pleased to inform you that the United States Olympic Committee's (USOC) Board of Directors, at its October 13, 2017, meeting, approved the American Canoe Association (ACA) as the National Governing Body in the United States for the Olympic sport of Canoe/Kayak. The USOC Board also approved ACA's membership in the USOC as an Olympic Sport Organization member. However, the ACA's recognition as an NGB and membership in the USOC is subject to the following condition:

The ACA must adopt at its October 22, 2017, Annual Membership Meeting the proposed amendments to its Bylaws (the final draft version dated August 24, 2017) submitted to the USOC staff for review.

If the proposed amendments are not approved, then the action of the USOC Board will have no effect and the ACA will not be recognized as the NGB for the Olympic sport of Canoe/Kayak. Further, the ACA will not be admitted as an Olympic Sport Organization member of the USOC. Please report back to the USOC by October 27, 2017, as to whether the amendments were adopted.

Additionally, the USOC Board did not approve the ACA's request for an exemption to Section 8.8 of the USOC Bylaws relating to athlete representation on certain ACA Councils and Committees. Thus, the ACA must comply with all requirements of Section 8.8 and ensure that appropriate athlete representation is achieved on all of its Councils and Committees.
