The first year an athlete can compete in an ICF competition (level 1 to 3 ) or in an international competition (level 4) is the year of their 15th birthday.
The last year an athlete can compete in the Junior age group is the year of their 18th birthday.
The last year an athlete can compete in the Under-23 age group is the year of their 23rd birthday.
All athletes wishing to be considered for the ICF Junior and U23 WCH National Team are required to have indicated their nomination for this event on the registration for this tour before March 7, 2023.

Multiple K4 Trials will be conducted to determine the WCH boat. To facilitate the fairest racing conditions possible, variable factors, such as wind, weather forecast, and more, will be taken into consideration when scheduling races. In order to win the K4 nomination, a K4 crew from one of the trials must beat the priority boat's time by over 2 seconds. The priority boat will race first to set the time standard. A maximum of five K4 Time Trials will be run on the 3rd day of Trials at least 45 minutes apart using the following process:

1. Time trial 1: The priority K 4 will be the athletes ranked 1, 2, 3, 4 from the team boat pool. They race to set the time standard that must be beaten by over 2 seconds.
2. Time trials 2: Athlete ranked 5 with 3 of the athletes from the team boat pool. They must beat the priority boat time by over 2 seconds in order to gain nomination.
3. Time trials 3: Athlete ranked 6 with 3 of the athletes from the team boat pool. They must beat the priority boat time by over 2 seconds in order to gain nomination.
4. Time trials 4: Athlete ranked 7 with 3 of the athletes from the team boat pool. They must beat the priority boat time by over 2 seconds in order to gain nomination.

The Head Coaches will objectively document all variables in the trials and report them to the Selection Committee. If the Head Coaches deem the weather
conditions or any other extenuating situation were inconsistent between trials, the needed 2 second win-margin may be disregarded and the Head Coaches will determine the boat for nomination. The Head Coaches rationale for the nomination will be presented to the Selection Committee for approval.

## v. NON-OLYMPIC U23 MEN'S KAYAK EVENT SELECTION WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The ACA High-Performance strategy prioritizes the Olympic events and the qualification for Non-Olympic events are selected using the following criteria:

1. The WINNER of the Men's K1 500m has the right of first refusal for that event. If an athlete declines, that event is offered to the next ranked athlete in the K1500m using athletes nominated to the WCH National Team.
2. Men's K1 200 m is offered to the WINNER of the Men's K1 200m. If an athlete declines, that event is offered to the next ranked athlete in the K1 200m using athletes nominated to the WCH National Team.

In order to win the K4 nomination, a K4 crew from one of the trials must beat the priority boat's time by over 2 seconds. The priority boat will race first to set the time standard. 10. During the team boat selection races, a variety of $C 2$ team boat combinations will be raced. The fastest boat combinations will be ranked in the U23 category and the Junior category. The fastest C 2 in each category will be named to the team.

## xxii. NON-OLYMPIC EVENT SELECTION:

1. U23 Men's $\mathrm{C} 1500 \mathrm{~m}-\mathrm{U} 23$ WINNER of the C 1500 m has the right of first refusal at this race. If an athlete declines, that event is offered to the next ranked athlete in the Cl 500 until that event is filled.
2. Junior Men's Cl 500m - Junior WINNER of the Cl 500 m has the right of first refusal at this race. If an athlete declines, that event is offered to the next ranked athlete in the C1500m until that event is filled.
3. U23 Men's Cl 5000 m is offered to the WINNER of the U23 Men's C1 1000 m . If an athlete declines, that event is offered to the next ranked athlete in the C1 1000 m until that event is filled.
4. Junior MCl 5000 m is offered to the WINNER of the Junior Men's Cl 1000 m . If an athlete declines, that event is offered to the next ranked athlete in the C1 1000 m until that event is filled.
5. U23 Men's C2 1000 m will be offered to the fastest boat selected from the team boat selection pool in the U23 division. If a boat crew declines, that event is offered to the next ranked crew in the team boat pool until that event is filled.
6. Junior Men's C2 1000 will be offered to the fastest boats selected from the team boat selection pool in the Jr. division. If a boat crew declines, that event is offered to the next ranked crew in the team boat pool until that event is filled.
7. U23 Men's C4 500 m will be selected from the team boat selection pool.
8. Junior Men's C4 500 m will be selected from the team boat selection pool.
9. During the team boat selection races, a variety of $C 4$ combinations will be raced. The fastest boat combination will be ranked in the U23 category and the Junior category. The fastest C 4 in each category will be named to the team.
10. Mixed C2 500 m will be offered to the two fastest athletes in the Men's and Women's C1 500m in the U23 and Junior categories. If either or both athletes decline, then the C 2 will be selected from the results of the respective team boat selection pool.
11. The mixed relay team will be selected from the National Team pool with preference given to the highest ranked athletes in the most relevant event at contested trials.

1. The WINNER (Highest Ranked U23) in the Senior Women's Cl 200m event will be nominated to the team and given the right of first refusal of that event at the U23 World Championships.
2. The WINNER (Highest Ranked Junior) in the Junior Women's Cl 200m event will be nominated to the team and given the right of first refusal of that event at the Jr. World Championships.
3. If one of the selected athletes declines, the nomination goes to the next ranked athlete until all spots are filled. The team boat athletes can only be nominated from the team boat selection pool.

5. The U23 WINNER of the Women's C1 500m will be selected to the U23 team boat selection pool. The next ranked U23 athletes in the C1500m will be selected into the team boat selection pool up to a maximum of 8 athletes.
6. The Junior WINNER of the Women's Cl 500 m will be selected to the U 23 team boat selection pool. The next ranked Junior athletes in the C 1500 m will be selected into the team boat selection pool up to a maximum of 8 athletes.
7. Women's Cl athletes selected to race Cl can choose not to be included in the team boat selection pool and only be considered for the team based on their singles performance. In such a case, the next ranked athlete will be selected into the team boat selection pool.
8. Team boats with partners in two categories will be considered in the older partners category.
9. An athlete has the right to be considered in multiple age categories, an example would be an athlete qualifies for the Junior team in a single and also qualifies for the team in the U23 category in a team boat.
10. During the team boat selection races, a variety of C 2 combinations will be raced. The fastest boat combination will be ranked in the U23 category and the Junior category. The fastest C 2 in each category will be named to the team.

6. Mixed C2 500 m will be offered to the two fastest athletes in the Men's and Women's C1 500m in the U23 and Junior categories. If either or both athletes decline, then the C 2 will be selected from the results of the respective team boat selection pool.
7. The mixed relay team will be selected from the National Team pool with preference given to the highest ranked athletes in the most relevant event at contested trials.
