ACA Instructor Audit Information

Calling all Instructor Trainer Educators, Instructor Trainers, and Instructors! If your current certification is set to expire this year- you might want to ensure that you have met the recertification requirements:

All: Maintain your ACA Membership and SEIC Registration

Instructors:

- 1. Successfully complete an appropriate Instructor update during your 4-tear certification period.
- 2. Teach and properly report two courses during this 4-year certification period: At least one being at your level of certification

Instructor Trainers:

- 1. Successfully complete an appropriate Instructor Trainer update during your 4-tear certification period.
- 2. Teach and properly report four courses during this 4-year certification period. Courses must include at least one IDW/ICE at your level of certification, one Update, and one skills or assessment course

Instructor Trainer Educators:

- 1. Complete the ITE renewal documents available on the ACA website. Find it here.
- 2. Teach and properly report at least six courses during your 4-year certification period. One must be a skills or assessment course, one must be an Instructor Update, and one must be an IDW/ICE at your highest level of certification. Evaluations from these courses must be submitted for review. Lastly, each ITE must teach at least one course with another IT or ITE in their discipline.

If you do not foresee that you will be able to complete these recertification requirements this year, please consider completing an extension form- the SEI Department will grant extensions on a case by case basis. Extensions allow an additional year to complete the above recertification requirements.

If you do not meet the recertification requirements, you will be sent a notification of your pending certification status and certification expiration date of 12/31/2011.

If you have taught courses and/or participated in an update: make sure it has been properly **reported!** See below for a list of our new easy, online report forms.
