

On behalf of the ACA Safety, Education, and Instruction Council, welcome to the SEIC Newsletter! This month, SEIC Chair Anna Levesque would like to make a book recommendation - about communication. As Instructors, Trainers, and Educators, the ability to communicate clearly and succinctly is remarkably important. The words we use and the ways in which we use them have the ability to empower and help a student's learning process or they can hurt and hinder the learning process. There are a variety of in-person ways that an ACA instructor, IT or ITE can earn the Paddlesports Angler Instructor Endorsement as well as a new method that has been authorized by SEIC for ITs and ITEs who have prior fishing expertise.
