savvy navvy is really as simple as 'Google Maps for boats.' Supporting both new and experienced boaters on the water, savvy navy supports not only power boats, but also kayakers and paddleboarders. Using official NOAA hydrographic data, the app shows essential marine information with a clean and easy-to-view interface for safety and ease of use, enabling better and quicker navigation. Some of its features include:

- Weather forecasts
- Automatic route planning
- Boat ramp information, ideal for anyone looking to launch
- Departure scheduler which enables boaters at a glance to see the best time to depart based on their route, wind, and tidal conditions
- Ability to record GPS tracks
- Satellite overlay
- Cloud and rind overlay
- Wind gusts
