

Using official NOAA hydrographic data, the app shows essential marine information with a clean and easy-to-view interface for safety and ease of use, enabling better and quicker navigation. Some of its features include:

- Weather forecasts
- Automatic route planning
- Boat ramp information, ideal for anyone looking to launch
- Departure scheduler which enables boaters at a glance to see the best time to depart based on their route, wind, and tidal conditions
- Ability to record GPS tracks
- Satellite overlay
- Cloud and rind overlay
- Wind gusts
