## House Introduces "EXPLORE" Bipartisan Recreation Policy Package

November 29, 2023, Congressman Westerman (R-AR) and Congressman Grijalva (D-AZ) introduced the Expanding Public Lands Outdoor Recreation Experiences (EXPLORE) Act, a

bipartisan package of outdoor recreation policy. The EXPLORE Act could serve as a companion to America's Outdoor Recreation Act (AORA), a similar package in the Senate.

One of the key bills that impacts paddlers presented in both EXPLORE and AORA, is the Simplifying Outdoor Access for Recreation Act (SOAR). Section 5 of the SOAR Act would allow guiding professionals, outfitters, and outdoor leaders more flexibility when it comes to their permits. Rafting companies for example could also offer kayaking tours under the same permit. Another proposed change to the permitting system included in the SOAR Act is to create a program so permit holders can return unused service days and allow for other guides and outfitters to use them.

Other highlights include the Biking on Long Distance Trails Act (BOLT) to identify and create more long-distance bike trails, the Protecting America's Rock Climbing Act (PARC) to safeguard Wilderness climbing, and permanent direction for the Outdoor Recreation Legacy Partnership and FICOR.

Like AORA, the EXLORE Act aims to improve outdoor recreation on America's public lands and waters. These bills take important steps to expand and improve outdoor recreation opportunities.

The ACA Tampa LEAD Program, held this November 10-13, was a remarkable event that brought together the American Canoe Association (ACA), Tampa Bay Kayak Anglers, Sun Coast Youth Conservation Center, and Florida Youth Conservation Centers Network in Apollo Beach, Florida. This was the fifth installment of the Leadership Exploration and Development (LEAD) program, which aims to provide a unique student-centered experience for participants from historically underrepresented communities within the ACA.

Throughout the four-day program, attendees had the opportunity to immerse themselves in the ACA's Community Paddlesport Leader curriculum. Guided by Trey Rouss and Jake Fitzroy, the participants engaged in various activities and workshops designed to enhance their leadership skills and knowledge in paddlesports and water safety.

What made this year's LEAD program particularly special was the involvement of three former LEAD participants. Chris Manning, Adrienne Gallup, and Tatiana Cox-Lopez who participated in the 2022 LEAD Program served as mentors to the first-time participants. ### 2023 ACA Slalom National Championships

Last week coaches and athletes from across the country along with athletes from Canada and Mexico gathered at RIVERSPORT in OKC for a weeklong training camp, culminating in the 2023 Slalom and Kayak Cross National Championships. It is a tradition that has been happening for many years over the Thanksgiving holiday and allows junior athletes attending their first Nationals to train alongside seasoned veterans. It also provided an opportunity for in-person committee meetings, and an educational session for volunteers to begin the process of becoming Nationals Officials.

Athletes got approximately 12 quality sessions on RIVERSPORT's world class whitewater. While the weather largely cooperated, race day was chilly, with the temperatures hovering just above freezing in the morning and some rain moving in later in the day.

When it was all said and done, three National Champions were crowned with Evy Leibfarth winning the Women's K1, Women's C1, and Women's Kayak Cross. Zach (Bug) Lokken narrowly edged out Casey Eichfeld to take the C1 Gold by just 0.16 seconds, and Josh Joseph took home the Men's K1 with Potomac Whitewater Racing Club sweeping the podium. Kaelin Friedenson followed up his Green Race win earlier in November by also winning the National Championship in Kayak Cross.

Many newly trained volunteers from RIVERSPORT helped support the event. The ACA would like to send a big thank you to the RIVERSPORT staff and all the officials who helped make this event a success. We would also like to thank Janusz Zebracki for all his help with logistics and coaching, and each of the coaches who were there to help athletes make progress. Last but not least, a big thank you to Nancy Templeton and Angela Lokken for coordinating and running the officials training.

The 2023 ICF SUP World Cup took place in Pattaya, Thailand, this November 15-19. In the Open Division, across the three competitive disciplines (sprint, long distance, and technical) the U.S. athletes threw down and earned two gold medals and two silver.
