Sarasota is a city south of Tampa on Florida's Gulf Coast. Sarasota has its own international airport. TAMPA airport is also only 1 hour away.


In Sarasota during April average daily high temperatures increase from 78°F to 82°F and it is overcast or mostly cloudy about 37% of the time.

Team Information Form:

To ensure the Host Organizing Committee is requesting that each federation complete the "Team Information form". This form is simply for operational planning and will not affect entries. We are requesting your team size estimate numbers as best estimate as you can provide.

Principles for Entries:

- Entries and accreditation requests must be made by the National Federations using the ICF's online entries System (SDP): https://icf.msl.es/icf/icf.jsp

- Numerical Entries for the Americas Olympic Qualifier: March 9, 2024
- Nominal Entries for the Americas Olympic Qualifier: April 13, 2024
 - Each athlete competing must be entered by name.
 - Team personnel must also be submitted for accreditation at this time. These entries will be used to produce the accreditation cards for all teams.

Reminder:

• Entries or accreditation requests sent directly to the committee or the competition organizers will <u>NOT</u> be accepted.









Participation Fee

Every participant (athletes, coaches, team staff) will be charged a <u>Participation Fee which is \$36 USD</u> per person, per day, from day of arrival (no earlier than Monday, April 22nd, 2024) till the departure day (no later than Thursday, April 25th, 2024).

Participation Fee includes the following services:

Non-Competition days:

- Accreditation services
- Usage of the course during opening hours
- Security on the course
- Ambulance and/or doctor at the course during opening hours
- Drinking water
- Toilets
- Boat storage facilities
- Boat Control facilities

Competition days:

- All above
- Doping Control
- Timing & Results system
- Boat Number distribution
- Results and information announcement
- Team tents & spaces

Transportation Information:

- Please note that the HOC <u>will not provide and manage transportation</u> before and during 2024 Sarasota for participants (athletes, Coaches, team Staff, etc.)
- Neither airport pick-up/drop-off services nor local transportation will be provided by the HOC. Teams need to be entirely self-sufficient regarding transportation.

Accommodation

Please note that the HOC <u>will not provide and manage accommodation</u> before and during the event. In agreement with the COPAC Canoe Sprint Committee, the HOC of the event will not manage the accommodation requests of teams. Lunch Order

- The Host Organizing Committee will provide lunches for a fee, on site for Nationals (Athletes, Coaches, Team Staff) from Monday April 22nd Thursday April 25th.
- Lunch will be available to pick up during the lunch period listed in the schedule. Exact location will be confirmed in the next bulletin.
- Price of the lunch on site will be \$20 USD per meal per person

- Please note that all catering fees will be included on accreditation invoices and sent to each nation's federation.

Payment Details

Once Nominal entries close, The Host will send an invoice for participation fee and lunch order to each Nation. The payment details of the wire transfer will be provided on the invoice.

All Participation and lunch fees MUST be paid prior to pick up of Accreditations in order to be eligible to compete in the competition.

Fees

Participation fee = \$36 USD per person/ per day Lunch Fee = \$20 USD per meal/ per day

Visa information

The VISA process to travel to the United States is critical to your team's participation at this event, applying early is the most important thing. The State Dept. recommends applying 90-120 days in advance of travel.
