

# American Canoe Association Regional Teams Initiative

#### Goals:

- 1. To grow participation in Slalom and Kayak Cross at the Youth level
- 2. To provide a meaningful race series for athletes under the age of 17
- 3. To allow athletes from across the country to interact and build relationships
- 4. To support local organizers and venues in the different regions
- 5. To improve collaboration and communication between the regions
- 6. To establish a pathway for athletes wanting to progress in Slalom and Kayak Cross

#### **REGIONS**

The regions below are suggested based on current active clubs and races being held.

- Northeast:
  - Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, New York, and Connecticut.
- Mid-Atlantic:
  - New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Maryland, District of Columbia, West Virginia, Virginia, and Delaware.
- Southeast:
  - Kentucky, Tennessee, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, Alabama, Mississippi, and Florida
- West:
  - Washington, Oregon, California, Nevada, Montana, Idaho
- Mountain West:
  - o Colorado, Arizona, New Mexico, Wyoming, Nebraska, Oklahoma, Texas, Kansas
- Mid-Continental: (no current active clubs or races)
  - Wisconsin, Minnesota, Michigan, Illinois, Indiana, Missouri, Iowa, Arkansas

#### **REGIONAL TEAMS SUMMARY**

- Age groups:
  - o U16
  - o U14
  - o U12
- To qualify athletes must race in three designated regional races before July 21st.
- The top two in each age-group and class, are eligible to be named to their Regional team
- Athletes selected will be awarded an ACA travel Stipend to cover travel expenses for the following event.
  - o Olympic Week Camp at RIVERSPORT, OKC with Junior Olympic Race

### **REGIONAL TEAMS CRITERIA**

Although the selection of the regional teams will be left up to each region, ACA will limit its awards according to the following criteria:

- 1. Awards will only be given to athletes who have completed three (3) qualifying races by July 21<sup>st</sup>.
- 2. Races will be used to rank the athletes according to the following rules of the regional racing series.
  - Points will be awarded based on a ICF Canoe & Kayak allocations as presented below:

- 3. The athlete must finish each race counted toward this total. (I.e., those receiving DNF's on both runs will not count as having attended that race.)
- 4. Regional teams should be announced and submitted to the ACA within 3 days of all qualifying races being completed.
- 5. Awards will be limited to two boats per class in each of the three age categories: U16, U14, and U12. Racers will be eligible only in their appropriate age category. Awards will be made only in the following classes: MK1, WKI, MC1, WC1.
- 6. The awards will be made after the designated competitions are completed, and evidence of athlete attendance is received.
- 7. Each athlete may receive only one monetary award.
- 8. ACA will not apply a regional residence requirement.

- 9. Recipients of awards must be ACA members.10. An athlete's eligibility for selection to a particular team category is determined by the athlete's "competition age" (age on December 31 of 2024).
- 11. The total award will be \$200 to the athlete paid by the ACA.
