International Boating and Water Safety Summit (IBWSS) Communications Award

At the 2024 International Boating and Water Safety Summit, the ACA Regional Activity Council (RAC) received a communication award for the Community Impact category. This program created partnerships between nationally certified ACA instructors with state agencies, regional paddling clubs, U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary, and additional paddlesports stakeholders in Tennessee and North Carolina. This effort taught "Kayaking 101" classes at state parks to kick off National Safe Boating Week in 2023, resulting in hands-on training for 279 students by 179 volunteers from 46 organizations, with an estimated in-kind donation of 1,872 volunteer hours. In addition, this effort generated 36 news stories that with more than 200,000 impressions.

RAC Secretary, Bev Cosslett, received this award on behalf of the ACA. Bev looks forward to the 2024 National Safe Boating week where she and ACA South Carolina State Director, Geoff Chambers, are working to bring Kayaking 101 courses to State Parks in South Carolina! We are looking forward to expanding this initiative to approximately 45 classes being hosted in state parks across 7 states: Tennessee, North Carolina, South Carolina, Florida, Georgia, Missouri and Texas!


ACA Competition Club Feature: RIVERSPORT Youth Canoe/Kayak Team

The RIVERSPORT Youth Canoe/Kayak Team gives kids the opportunity to race in Olympicstyle canoe/kayak competitions — fun, exciting, and a great way to get involved in one of America's fastest growing water sports!

The team is co-ed and open to youth ages 8+. Youth get on the water in rec kayaks to get started, then move up to racing canoes (kneeling) or kayaks (seated). Kids who are interested in whitewater slalom can also learn the basics of this sport in RIVERSPORT's whitewater center — first on calm water, then in gentle rapids as their confidence and skills grow.

Our youth paddlers compete in regional and national events in sprint and slalom and have a chance to see the sport at its highest level as RIVERSPORT hosts international race events. Speaking of... the second weekend of Canoe Slalom Olympic Team Trials take place at Riversport OKC today!

The 2024 Americas Continental Olympic Qualifier & 2024 Panam Canoe Sprint Championships took place this April 23-26! We were thrilled to host this event on home turf in Sarasota, Florida at Nathan Benderson Park.

U.S. athletes had incredible performances, notably Jonas Ecker and Aaron Small won the Men's K2 500m race and qualified for the Olympics this summer in Paris! ACA Instructor, Drew Gregory, takes the win at 2024 Bassmaster Kayak Series Championship

With a two-day total of ten bass measuring 180.50 inches, ACA Kayak and Kayak Fishing Instructor Drew Gregory wins the 2024 Yamaha Rightwaters Bassmaster Kayak Series Championship. Gregory collected \$25,000; part of a \$56,350 total cash purse split among the Top 16 anglers in the tournament. In all, 164 competitors representing 30 states and Canada took part. Rus Snyders, the 2023 Champion and an ACA Instructor, presented the

trophy to Gregory on a stage nobody in kayak fishing would have thought possible only five years ago: the Bassmaster Classic Stage.

Drew discussed that one of his key competitive advantages in the field of kayak anglers was that he had dialed in efficient outfitting, trim and weight distribution on his kayak so that he could maximize the efficiency of his motor and combine it with powerful paddling when required.
