Arkansas River, Salida, CO July 25-30

The races were run on a roughly 4-mile section of the Arkansas River from Vallie Bridge to Trading Post. Water level varied around 780 cfs +/-. (Although shallow in some places, this is generally a very good water level for open canoes from Salida down to Trading Post.) Race times varied from 31 to 38 minutes for the long race and from 9 to 12 minutes for the sprint. Jeff Owen set both fastest course times in his OC-1F14 boat: 30:59 in the long race and 8:44 in the sprint.
