    - c. Classification scenario labels aligned with classification counts much more logical (E1, A7, D3, etc.)

    - a. A: 7 classifications (no change, 7 current, no change)
    - b. B: 9 classifications (no change, 9 current, no change)
    - c. C: 12 classifications (up from 11, 12 current, no change)
