ACA Paddlesports' New Leader & Guide Certification Pathway

The transformational new ACA Leader Certification Pathway equips paddlers with essential skills in leadership, trip planning, risk management, and rescue. Standing alongside the ACA's well-established Instructor Certification pathway, this streamlined program is designed to empower new leaders and guides with professional certification. With accessible entry points and a strong focus on decision-making, planning, and safety, the program empowers new leaders and guides—whether they're leading day trips on a nearby lake, taking their fellow club members down the local class II run, or guiding multi-day expeditions in remote wilderness settings.

The ACA Leader and Guide certifications are unique in that they are structured around the paddling environment, not specific paddlecraft. These pathways are designed for protected waterways, coastal, and river environments.
